Sign up for Children's Sacramental Preparation

Just a reminder that completion of the Sacraments of Initiation for children is a two-year process. Classes are held weekly during the school year and provide a child-friendly opportunity to grow in faith and community. We hope these classes will be a great resource to you as you share Christ's love with your child.

The first year usually coincides with first grade. Please note: The first year of Sacramental Preparation may be completed in **one** of two ways:

- Attendance in the Billings Catholic Schools
- Attendance in a Parish Children's Ministry class

The second year of classes will include sacramental preparation and reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and the completion of the Sacraments of Initiation: Confirmation and First Eucharist. This is only offered through the parish and **not** in the Catholic schools.

Registration forms for classes are now available on the tables in the Gathering Area, online through the Children's Ministry webpage, or at the parish office. The Lodgepole Complex Wildfire in eastern Montana has burned over 226,000 acres. The group of four fires covers an area 40 miles by 20 miles and growing. The incident management team recently called the four fires a classification called "megafires" (fires that exceed 100,000 acres). Farmers and ranchers are seriously impacted by the fires with the loss of grazing land, hay, cattle, crops on farm land and buildings.
