

## Online Giving – Electronic Funds Transfer

### A Convenient Way to Donate to Your Parish

- Save the trouble of writing out a check each week.
- Eliminate the need to mail your contribution if you are absent.
- Contribute to various parish funds through one electronic transfer.

### You Are in Control

- Select the amount(s) you wish to give to each fund.
- Change any amount you wish to give at any time.
- Cancel at any time.

### It is Easy to Participate

Go to [www.stpiusxblgs.org](http://www.stpiusxblgs.org) and click on “Donate” at the center top of the website. Use either the “Give Online via Parishsoft” button or the area for Paypal and Venmo transactions. Fill in the appropriate information.

### OR

Complete the enclosed Online Giving Withdrawal Authorization and return it to the Parish Office or place it in the Sunday collection basket.

Many people currently utilize electronic payments to pay their mortgage, insurance premiums, utility bills and many other obligations. It takes less time and paperwork for both the payer and payee, which translates into less cost than conventional check writing. Any changes can be done by you by going to your online giving account or by contacting our parish administrator at the parish office. In addition to your normal parish contribution, you may choose to donate to any or all of the other St. Pius X funds (i.e. Ministry, Cemetery, Building & Maintenance, and Fr. Steve Tokarski Scholarship Endowments; Capital Improvement; etc.). You can even pay for your cemetery plot in Calvary Cemetery through electronic fund transfer if you desire.
